

PRESIDENT

It is with the deepest of remorse that I report to you that Long Island ABATE has lost one of our finest, Steve Sorensen. Steve went to bed on January 25th and never woke the next morning. The autopsy was inconclusive as to the cause and tests are being conducted to figure out why he passed. As most of you know, Steve was in a very serious motorcycle accident in October, when a motorist forced him off the Long Island Expressway at highway speed (not intentionally). Steve suffered a broken bone in his neck as well as double/blurred vision and occasional dizziness since the accident. It is not known if this had anything to do with his death or not, but we will share the test results as soon as we receive them from his family. Steve never wanted to hold an official title within LI ABATE, but I believe he was the hardest working volunteer out there! Many of you saw his level of involvement at every event we held, but most of you are unaware of his level of effort and dedication in-between events. I would not be exaggerating if I told you that Steve and I communicated by either; in person, telephone, text or email approximately 25 days per month! The man was ALWAYS thinking or working on something for LI ABATE! I'm going to cut this short because I haven't absorbed or accepted the fact that he's gone yet. I will express my personal feelings of loss at another time, after I allow them to come out. LI ABATE is working very closely with Steve's family and will share any info as we receive it. There will be a celebration of his life in the coming months which we will pass on to you once it is scheduled. Goodbye for now, and Rest In Peace Steve Sorensen!!!

The Albany Chapter of NY ABATE posted about the sentencing of an individual who crossed into oncoming traffic and severely injured a couple on their motorcycle in June of 2014. The driver was arrested for the 3rd time for drunk driving and was being sentenced in Albany court on January 29th. Nick LaMorte, Mike Lauro and I drove to Albany that morning and joined the Albany Chapter (pictured below) in the courtroom as we showed support for the 2 victims. The driver was sentenced to 2 1/3 - 7 years in prison for Aggravated Vehicular Assault which is a class C felony. We were very pleased to see our Brothers & Sisters from NY ABATE get involved in the court process and hope that this spreads throughout the entire state. *Continued on next page*

Sandy and Daniel were so appreciative to see all of us there to support them through this tough time.



Steve Sorensen was my motorcycle instructor 10 years ago, and I will never forget how he made me feel at ease especially when one of the instructors told me I was not going to pass my road test. He walked over, asked me what was going on and talked to me for a while about life. Then he said to go ride. On the day of my test, he and his sister Christine were both there and when I passed he told me it was time to relax. Steve always had a funny story, and was a bit mischievous and spoke his mind. I had the privilege of "starring" with him in my first and only commercial last year. And recently, he showed up at a Veterans Funeral, and I got to ride next to him for a while. I know how much he missed riding after his accident, and how much he wanted to be at that funeral. I made him ride in front of me so I could keep an eye on him along with Rory. It was the last time I was ever going to ride with my friend. He had let me test ride his Road King before I bought mine, and when he worked for Lighthouse Harley he made sure they took care of my bike and when I was leaving their parking lot with the bike for like the 1000th time and we both realized they screwed up something else, and we both just laughed. He never batted an eye when I struggled parking my bike, he would always do it for me. And I had the opportunity to ride on the back of his bike once during Street Smarts, and as much as he liked to scrap the floor boards, and as tightly I as I held onto him while he was showing me his turns, I loved every minute of it. I am heartbroken that he is gone, but I know he will be among the angels watching out for all of us. 
We are blessed and honored to do this for our friend who felt education was very important .

Comfort Stop Forearm extended, fist clenched with short up and down motion,



Refreshment Stop Fingers closed, thumb to mouth.



Turn Signal On Open and close hand with fingers and thumb extended.



Pull Off Arm positioned as for right turn, forearm swung toward shoulder.



Cops Ahead Tap on top of helmet with open palm down.



Fuel Arm out to side pointing to tank with finger extended.

Jackie / Membership: Kim is currently helping Jackie with the membership program. LI ABATE over 1,400 members and continues to grow. Memberships can be renewed by mail, online or at a membership meeting. Memberships can be renewed at any time. Your current membership will be extended for one year. It is imperative that members renew and that we keep our membership numbers up. It is the only way we can be effective when we meet with public officials, as we are representing over 1400+ members. If you are not receiving LI ABATE newsletters or e-mails, please let Jackie know and she will update her e-mail data base.

Nancy / Newsletter: A link was sent out to members for the January 2016 newsletter. Nancy encourages all to send her pictures, articles, stories, event flyers, etc., for publication in our newsletter. **Website:** Holiday party pictures have been posted on our website. LI ABATE memberships / renewals can be processed online.

Mike / Public Relations: Mike will begin to publicize our Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Run (which will be on April 3) next month.

Joe / Safety Officer: LI ABATE has forms to be filled out for complaints about road conditions. Municipalities are now ordering asphalt for road repairs, so the more informed municipalities are now, the more prepared they can be.

Kathy / Products: Products are available for purchase at all membership meetings. Kathy is running a new t-shirt design contest. Get your designs in to her by the March membership meeting. The winner will get a free 5 year membership to LI ABATE and a t-shirt with their winning design.

Old Business

Court Cases: LI ABATE continues to monitor cases where a motorcyclist is seriously injured by a motorist. This is taken very seriously by the District Attorney and the presiding Judge on the case, as any advocacy group in attendance makes a difference in court proceedings and outcomes. Due to LI ABATE's presence in court, the DA has informed the Suffolk County Police Department that any accident involving a motorcycle must go to the DA Bureau Chief to sign off on. LI ABATE is currently tracking the case of the driver, Ndala, who hit and killed **Tom Heisenbuttle**, a motorcyclist and former Vice President of the Long Island Chapter of ABATE of NY. Ndala subsequently fled the scene of the accident. He is being charged with 1st degree vehicular manslaughter and 2nd degree manslaughter, and held on one million dollar bail. The next court date for this case is January 26 in the chambers of Judge Steven Braslow. Please check postings on Facebook for further information. LI ABATE is also monitoring an accident occurring on Sunrise Hwy, in which a member of Riders Don't Play MC was hit from behind a suffered serious injury. This case is now under investigation for leaving the scene of an accident resulting in injury and driving at an unsafe speed. Details will be provided as they are received.

Motorcycle Only Checkpoints: There has not been a motorcycle only checkpoint in Suffolk County by the Suffolk County Police Department since September 2014. Nationally, the MRF has been lobbying against motorcycle only checkpoints. Currently there is a federal bill which includes language prohibiting NHTSA from funding any state for the purpose of motorcycle only checkpoints. (States get grant money for MOC through the federal government.) Nationally, we are very close to getting all federal funds for MOC eliminated.

Scholarship Committee: Long Island ABATE has established a scholarship fund, which this year is being dedicated to **Stavros Dalambakis**, who was the inspiration for starting this fund upon his death last February. We are looking for a committee to develop criteria and procedures in order to implement this fund this year. **Debbie, Pastor Gerry and Ice Cream John** volunteered to be on this committee.

Life Insurance: As a member of LI ABATE, you are entitled to a free \$4000 life insurance policy. The insurance company will send out a letter informing you of this policy. (The insurance

company gives LI ABATE the letters and postage. We put on our own mailing labels. We do not give out member information.) A card will be included with this letter telling you to contact an insurance representative about this insurance. You do not have to send in this card. The life insurance will automatically be given to your estate.

New Business

Dealership Packets: George, our Sgt. At Arms, has been diligently working on packets to be offered to motorcycle dealers informing them about LI ABATE, and encouraging them to promote us through memberships. With the implementation of this program, LI ABATE will give publicity to dealers and in turn, dealers will help to increase our membership. If anyone knows or has a relationship with a dealer, please contact George. Thank you to those members, **Vinny, Mark, Mike, Steve, Josephine** and **Alex,** who have offered to help with this program.

Organizational Meeting for the 70 motorcycle clubs on Long Island took place on January 9th. The purpose of this meeting was to discuss runs and events for 2016. LI ABATE was very well received. A calendar of runs / events is currently being worked on.

Port Jefferson Parking: LI ABATE has been renting 50 parking spots in the Town of Brookhaven parking lot in order to provide free and unlimited parking for motorcyclists. This costs LI ABATE \$2500 for the year. The Business Improvement District of Port Jefferson has supported this endeavor and has reimbursed LI ABATE \$2000. We have learned that one member of BID has objected to reimbursing us for this free parking since motorcycles continue to park on Main St. While we do not mandate that motorcycles park in this designated area, we do encourage motorcyclists to take advantage of this free, unlimited parking space since parking on Main St. is strictly limited to 30 minutes (they do chalk tires). Steve Sorensen suggested we put cards in businesses and give out palm cards informing motorcyclists of this free parking.

LI ABATE Handbook: LI ABATE will be printing a 2016 handbook. The handbook will be limited to 66 pages. Advertising prices are the same as last year: \$50 for a half-page ad, and \$100 for a full page ad. These prices are for camera ready layouts. (There is an additional \$25 fee for those ads that require artwork or layout. If you advertised with us last year, we have your artwork on file.) The fee is due along with advertising copy. The deadline for advertising in this handbook will be March 1st, so the handbooks can be printed and available at our Awareness Run in April. The centerfold of this handbook will once again list bike runs and events.
