



Hi Guys,

Hope everyone had a great holiday season! Well it's time to start off a brand new year. I just came from the Board meeting and we're all so excited about all the upcoming events.

First off, we had great success with all the members who came to me with road hazards and great feedback from the local Towns. Now with membership on the rise, Brookhaven and Islip can't seem to do enough for us. I hope the other towns will get on board also. Let's continue the great work.

I have received the Suffolk County Sheriff's Office Announcement. Basically it is a summary of accidents and percentages such as weather, time of day, road conditions, driver's age and the big one alcohol related crashes. If anyone is interested, contact me at a meeting or e-mail and I'll be happy to review the material with you. I really don't like posting this kind of stuff, but in the long run it might help us avoid some mishaps. It might interest you to know that on the whole, we as motorcyclist are doing the right thing according to the report.

Now I know the riding season is over for most of us, but if you take your bike out on that occasional rare day when the sun is up and temps rising try to only stay out during daylights hours. Cars don't see us during normal riding season; they certainly aren't looking for us now. Some of you know what I'm talking about.

But if you're laying up your bike for the winter, December's American Iron has a great article by John Frank about winter storage ideas. There are many things we might not think of like location the first step is determining where. As for the fuel system, that age old question full or empty, fluid changes before or after? Fogging parts, how is this done then and now? Clean machine, dirt and grime retain moisture. Tire tips, last year we got a lot of info from Steve's Motorcycle School, this takes it one step further. The battery age and poor storage can kill any battery. Finally, steel wool keeps rodents out of the exhaust system. If you want to read the article in its entirety, American Iron can be found on line at AIMAG.com. There's enough to worry about when riding, safety begins with you!

<u>1st Vice President</u>: Billy nominated **Wayne** for the office of 1st Vice President. John seconded the nomination. Wayne accepted the nomination.


