

# PRESIDENTS PAGE

Well, May is here, and we have a lot of work ahead of us this riding season! As you know, May is Motorcycle Awareness Month in Suffolk County and as such, we try to get our message out there as much as possible to Watch for Motorcyclists! We are off to a GREAT start thanks to our member **Kathy Pfeil** and **Brookhaven Town Offi**-



cials! Kathy approached Councilman Dan Panico about partnering with ABATE and putting up motorcycle awareness signs throughout Brookhaven Town. Dan immediately agreed to do so and Councilwoman Kathy Walsh quickly Co-sponsored the resolution. With the full support of Town Supervisor Ed Romaine, the resolution was unanimously approved. Brookhaven Town has 6 Council districts with a Council person in each one. Therefore they have constructed and installed a 4'x8' sign in each council district reminding drivers that it is motorcycle season and to look for motorcycles. It has the ABATE name and logo on the bottom right of each sign and the respective council persons name along with the Supervisors name on the bottom left side. Thank you Kathy Pfeil and all the Brookhaven Town Officials!!!

We have also renewed our county permit and ABATE will be reinstalling our 4'x5' awareness signs on major county roadways. If you own a piece of property or can get permission from a property owner who has property on a heavily traveled roadway, we will gladly install an awareness sign if you would like us to. We also have <a href="https://www.hundreds.org/new-hundreds">hundreds</a> of 18"x24" lawn signs that are available for free. Just let us know your address and we will get it to you. We will be setting up a motorcycle awareness booth at many events this year. The more that people learn about what we do, the more invitations we are receiving to set up at events. We give away lawn signs, bumper stickers, safety data and more. We will be set up at Newsday's bike and car show on Pinelawn rd in Melville on Saturday, May 11th. Come on down and enjoy the event, it is free and they expect over 13,000 people there.

March 17<sup>th</sup> ABATE rode in the St Patty's Day Parade in Rocky Point. There was an anticipated crowd of 40,000 spectators that day who now have heard of ABATE and thanks to **Tracy Jahrsdoerfer**, about 1,000 of them took home a free motorcycle awareness bumper sticker. Let's hope they use them!

At the last Suffolk County Traffic Safety Board meeting (SCTSB) our **Safety Officer Joe Pizzo** requested that all Suffolk County vehicles have a motorcycle awareness bumper sticker on them. It is being considered and hopefully they will agree to do this.

In case you haven't noticed, our goal is to get people to LOOK FOR MOTORCYCLISTS while driving! And we are going to utilize every opportunity to get that message across. You can help us by taking a free lawn sign and bumper stickers for you and your friends.

We recently held our annual Safety & Awareness Run (and Bike Blessing) on April 14<sup>th</sup> in which we raised over \$6,000 which will be used EXCLUSIVELY for motorcycle safety & awareness throughout the year! We could not have accomplished this without the full support of; Full Throttle Magazine, SC Executive Steve Bellone, SC Police Dept, NYSDMV, WBAB, Rushing Wind Biker Church, Red River In, and the various presenters and vendors! 





#### Motorcycle Only Checkpoint Bill To Be Dropped

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) reports, Congressman Jim Sensenbrenner from Wisconsin, announced Monday, April 15th that he will file a bill to prohibit the federal funding of motorcycle only roadside checkpoints.

Sensenbrenner had this to say in a "Dear Colleague" that is circulating in the House of Representatives. "In the 112th Congress, I introduced H.R. 904, a bill to prohibit the Department of Transportation (DOT) from providing funds to state and local authorities for the purpose of creating motorcycle only checkpoints. Section 1 of the Stop Motorcycle Checkpoint Funding Act contains the same language as H.R. 904. However, this bill also contains language to force the DOT to focus motorcycle safety efforts on crash prevention programs, not national helmet mandates."

The bill will officially be introduced on May 6, 2013 and get its official bill number then. However, we must start the push now. It's important to contact your sitting member of the House of Representatives and ask them to be an original cosponsor of this important legislation. Ask them to contact Congressman James Sensenbrenner and lend their support. An "Original Cosponsor" is someone who supports the bill before it is made public and is a way to strongly support a new bill.



Educational displays will include: Dan Montamuro from the NYS Governor's Traffic Safety Board, Suffolk County Police Dept., Steve's Motorcycle School , Long Island Rides, Gold Wing Road Riders Association and Big Apple Motorcycle School. Music will be provided by WBAB. Coffee / bagels will be available. KSU at 12:00 for a police escorted ride to the Red River In, Yaphank. Music will be played by the Long Island Street Survivors. All funds raised from this event will be devoted to promote motorcycle awareness.

5/4 – NYS ABATE Regional Meeting. **Tanya Cruz**, our regional director, will be hosting a regional meeting (which includes the Long Island chapter, Brooklyn chapter and Brooklyn Alliance chapter) here at Cathedral Pines at 12:00pm. NYS ABATE President and Vice President will attend. Any ABATE members are also welcome to attend.

Town of Brookhaven / LI ABATE signs: LI ABATE member Kathy Pfeil made a proposal to Dan Panico, Deputy Town Supervisor and town councilmen in her district, to form a partnership between LI ABATE and each council district to post signs promoting motorcycle awareness. A resolution, sponsored by Dan Panico and town councilwoman Kathy Walsh was presented to the town board, and overwhelmingly approved, to post such signs from April through June, in each town council district. Brookhaven Town Supervisor Ed Romaine and other council members gave praise to LI ABATE and the work that we do to promote motorcycle safety and awareness.

Additional motorcycle awareness signs, made by LI ABATE, will again be posted, pending approval, in front of each police precinct and on county roads. We must be vigilant in our promotion of motorcycle awareness. With this in mind, Jim reports of two recent motorcycle accidents. In Babylon, motorcyclist John Hart was killed when a motorist failed to yield

to his right of way and made a left turn in front of him. In Port Jefferson, a 23 year old motorcyclist sustained non-life threatening injuries from a motorist also making a left turn, failing to yield to the right of way. Dan LoSquadro, former NYS Assemblyman, is the newly elected Superintendent of the Brookhaven Highway Department. Dan has been a supporter of motorcyclists' issues in the past, and we look forward to a continued relationship regarding road conditions in Brookhaven.




