PRESIDENTS PAGE

I would like to use this opportunity to say goodbye to a fellow ABATE member who meant a great deal to me! Her name was Marcy and she was a Charter member of the Delaware County chapter of ABATE of NY. When that chapter failed to grow she joined our Long Island chapter. She didn't grow up on a motorcycle but she always admired the way her family and friends would travel and meet other riders with similar interests. So at the age of 65 she decided that she had missed out on the joy and excitement of riding long enough. She and her husband Jim (70 years old) both took riding lessons and they both got their motorcycle licenses. Soon after they realized that the longer the trip they took, the more sense it would make to ride on the same bike together. Therefore they went out and bought a 1988 Honda Gold Wing trike and started their out of state adventures. Then they upgraded to a 2005 Gold Wing and have been traveling everywhere together. They joined the Hudson Hyland Retreads MC and the GWRRA (Gold Wing Road Riders Association). They were on the road all the time with their new found friends and traveled everywhere with these groups.

On the way home from a several day trip in Pennsylvania, Marcy started to get a sore throat and a bad headache. She spent several weeks being told that she was suffering from allergies. When the headache became unbearable in July she went for an MRI and learned that she had lung cancer that had traveled to her brain and that it was inoperable. She immediately decided against chemo and agreed to try radiation to reduce the swelling in the brain which was causing the unbearable headache. After 4 out of 10 prescribed radiation treatments she decided to stop the radiation because the tumors had shrunk enough to relieve the severe headache. She didn't want the remaining treatments to diminish the quality of life that she had left. She understood her situation and wanted to be as strong as possible in order to tie up as many loose ends for her family as possible. She even met with the undertaker to make her final plans. She then went under the care of the Catskill Area Hospice. They saw to her every need and did a wonderful job making her as comfortable as possible! Marcy spent a few weeks at home greeting the many visitors who came from all over to say goodbye to her. During that time she displayed the utmost bravery and courage that I have ever witnessed. I often tell myself how I think I will react when my time comes and I sometimes wonder if I will have the courage to actually face it the way I plan to. Marcy put her friends and family first by handling this tragedy with such courage that it made it easier for others to accept the situation. One thing is for sure, I am truly impressed and proud of her courage and I only hope that the apple doesn't fall far from the tree and that I will be that strong when my time comes.

Goodbye **MOM!** I hope you know how much you were loved and how much you will be missed!!!





MEETING MINUTES

ABATE membership meeting 8-13-13 at the Cathedral Pines Activity Bldg., Middle Island

Members enjoyed a barbecue before the start of the meeting. Thank you again to **Bob**, from the **Bikers for Christ MC**, for all of the cooking.

Meeting began at 7:40 with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Officers from the Suffolk County Police Department were scheduled as guest speakers for tonight's meeting, however Officer Tedero's father passed away Sunday night. We offer our condolences to the Tedero family. SCPD will be present at our September 10th meeting.

Suffolk County Park Police Officer, Greg Link, addressed membership about the upcoming LI ABATE campout, which will take place at Suffolk County Park, Cathedral Pines this upcoming weekend. Officer Link welcomed us for the weekend and expressed appreciation for all that LI ABATE does for the motorcycle community. He spoke of an unfortunate situation that occurred last year and asked that we be mindful during this year's campout.

At tonight's meeting, it was brought to the attention of LI ABATE that groups of motorcycles were being pulled over by law enforcement. *

Road Reapers Secretary, Russ, spoke of his group being followed approximately 4 miles by a police officer in July, and subsequently pulled over. When asked why they were being pulled over, the reply was, "because of the patch on your back". Riders were ultimately let go after some discussion. * On another occasion, two Road Reapers were pulled over for loud pipes. When the riders asked for the decibel level, the officer reported that he didn't need it as the pipes were non-stock. Both riders were ticketed.

* **Lost Souls President, Jimmy**, reported that his vice-president was pulled over while riding his motorcycle for "motorcycle safety". He also reported hearing that more than 4 motorcycles riding together require a parade permit. * On the Guardians of the Children Poker Run, 6 motorcycle riders wearing club patches were pulled over by NYS Troopers while other bikes were not. *Please report these incidents to our hotline, 888-LIABATE, when they occur. LI ABATE has a good relationship with the Suffolk County Police Department, and Jim will sit with the Police Chief regarding these incidents.*

Five members of the Long Island Chapter of ABATE of NY have opened a new 501C3 corpora-

tion, Long Island ABATE, Inc. We are now in the process of applying for grant money to be used for increased motorcycle safety and awareness here on Long Island.

Motorcycle parking in Port Jefferson: As discussed at the last general membership meeting, Jim presented a proposal for a motorcycle only parking lot within the village parking lot, located next to Tommy's Bar on Main Street. BID (the Business Improvement District of Port Jefferson) opposed this proposal, feeling that motorcyclists would quickly outgrow this small lot. Free motorcycle parking in the Town of Brookhaven Parking Lot was given as an alternate site, however the Village of Port Jefferson has, in the past, unsuccessfully sought the town's approval. Jim stated that **Brookhaven Town Supervisor, Ed Romaine** is very supportive of LI ABATE and offered to meet with him. Jim did meet with Ed Romaine's Chief Deputy, **Eddie Morris** and proposed that all motorcycles be given free parking access in the town lot, with an annual contribution of \$2500 (\$2000 from BID and \$500 from LI ABATE) given to the Town of Brookhaven for this privilege. This proposal was approved. *We are currently awaiting a confirmation signature from the Mayor of Port Jefferson before this free parking can be implemented. Please check e-mail updates or our website for the latest information.* Once again, the Village of Port Jefferson welcomes motorcyclists. LI ABATE asks that you please ride respectfully through the village.

LI ABATE has been attending various community street fairs as well as many motorcycle events, setting up a booth and getting the word out about motorcycle safety and awareness. We have spoken with many riders who were involved in motorcycle accidents and family members of those riders who were seriously injured or killed in a motorcycle accident. We have lawn signs, bumper stickers, information about LI ABATE, etc. available to everyone who stops by our booth.

Veterans Appreciation Run: LIABATE has a total of \$40,000 to be given to various veterans organizations with minimal or no overhead costs, that are helping our veterans on Long Island. Thanks to the generosity of our members, we were able to raise \$10,000, which was then matched by three backers through the efforts of our treasurer and organizer of this run, **Bill Quinn**. We will be disseminating these funds at our October 8th general membership

meeting, which will be held at the Centereach VFW on Horseblock Road. Like last year, we will make this a dinner meeting.


