

Motorcycle Only Checkpoint (MOC) update- As a result of the MOC performed this summer by the SCPD, I testified before the Suffolk County Legislatures Public Safety Committee and as a result, Committee Chairwoman Kate Browning set up a meeting for us to discuss the issue with Suffolk County Police Commissioner Tim Sini and Chief of Department Stuart Cameron. I explained the history of the MOC's and our objection to them based on the discriminatory aspect of them and that they do not achieve the results that the police are seeking. The Commissioner & Chief explained that they didn't see it as discriminatory and they were trying to reduce motorcycle fatalities. After a one hour conversation I think it's fair to say that each side left the meeting with a better understanding of the others point of view and the Commissioner has promised to reevaluate the tactic of MOC's and we will meet again to continue the conversation. This issue is not over as far as we are concerned but on a positive note, there doesn't seem to be any similar discriminatory stops of motorcyclists taking place since our meeting, with the exception of 1 questionable stop of a Motorcycle Club rider on the day of Full Throttle Magazines Biker Build Off event. That seems to be an isolated incident and is being reviewed separately. Let's hope that this issue gets resolved favorably! Stay tuned...

Court cases- one of the major cases we are monitoring is the case against Sabelo Ndala who killed Tom Heissenbuttel in November 2015. On Saturday July 16th we learned that **Judge Stephen Braslow** was going to accept a plea deal on Monday July 18th which would result in a 3-6 year sentence for Ndala. We spoke with Tom's widow, Regina, and she was very unhappy with the deal, so we showed up Monday morning with a letter for the judge, 2 dozen ABATE members, including **Attorney Dan Rodgers**, and channel12, to express our dissatisfaction with the plea deal. To the Judges credit, he reevaluated the prearranged deal and revoked the 3-6 year deal and offered a more reasonable 4-8 year deal. The defendant and his attorney were furious but were unable to do anything about it. I'm very proud to say that one month later Ndala, very reluctantly accepted the 4-8 year prison sentence! The reason this occurred is because Long Island ABATE has established a very credible reputation within the court system and because our members were willing to show up when called upon in order to make the impact needed, when necessary! Thank you to each and every member of LI ABATE!!!

Campout- This year's campout went very well. Unfortunately we had 4 hours of rain on Saturday afternoon but it didn't interfere with our fun! I want to thank the following for making the event such a success; our **Chairperson**, **Joe Pizzo**, for producing a great event as well as all the volunteers that helped him! **Jack & Ann from Deadwood Choppers** for judging the bike contest, **Wayne Blast** for all the signs & trophies, **Yankee Rebel**, **Wildflower**, and **Simple Days** for entertaining us all day and night! And our **Honorary Head Cook**, **Morgan**, who has cooked at EVERY campout we have had! Thank you all!!!


2nd Vice President



LI ABATE membership meeting 8-9-16, Ronkonkoma, NY

BBQ before the meeting. Thank you to Joe, Claudia, Jackie and Mike for doing all of the cooking.

7:35 Meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance

Welcome new members and guests.

Our website has been hacked. We are currently in the process of rebuilding the site.

Minutes for the July 2016 membership meeting could not be posted on the website. Hard copied were available for members present at tonight's meeting.

Motion 22-2016: Motion to accept July 2016 membership meeting minutes. (Seconded) All in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Detailed income and expenditures were reported. *Bill also thanked all who are contributing to the veteran's appreciation fund. All donations will be quadrupled.*

Motion 23-2016: Motion to accept treasury report. (Seconded) All in favor.

Committee Reports

Membership: Currently, LI ABATE has 1650+ members. All membership renewals expiring in August have been mailed out. It is imperative that members renew and that we keep our membership numbers up. We are also encouraging all members to recruit new members, as the more members we have, the more effective we can be when we meet with public officials. Membership pins will no longer be mailed, in effort to save on mailing costs. A coupon will be included with your membership renewal, which can be exchanged for a pin at any membership meeting or LI ABATE booth. If anyone continues to have problems receiving e-mail updates, please see Jackie or Nancy and your e-mail address will be corrected.

Nancy / Website: Our website remains under construction. Nancy will send a link to the website when it is up. Automatic renewals are still being processed through pay pal. **Newsletter:** All recent newsletters will be posted on the website when the rebuild is completed.

Mike / Public Relations: Mike is working on putting together a motorcycle safety course, along with Don Gomo, Empire State Motorcycle Safety Education Program and Steve Bertinelli, On the Road Again, an MSF state organized motorcycle training school. This course will offer rider skills with a discount to all LI ABATE members. Additional information will be passed on when the date and location is finalized.

Doreen / Legislative Liaison: Doreen sent Senator Robach, chair of the transportation committee, articles on recent motorcycle accidents. Senator Robach also reports witnessing a fatal motorcycle accident, and proposes to draft a bill regarding driver education to keep motorcyclists safe on the road. Doreen went on to speak of exhaust pipe modification legislation. **Marty, Mike** and **Dale** have volunteered to assist Doreen with this legislation. Currently <u>any</u> exhaust modification, even if modification remains under the NYS required decibel level, is against the law. Language stating exhaust pipes may not be modified to exceed 86 decibels, equal to automobiles, will be included in the proposed legislation.

Kathy / Products: Kathy has been running great sales on merchandise at membership meetings. Ladies tank tops in white, black and pink, are now available for \$10. LI ABATE t-shirts in a variety of colors are available for \$10. Veterans Appreciation Run t-shirts are \$15. Kathy also has patches for the Veterans Appreciation Run, Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Run and yearly rockers.

Old Business

LI ABATE Scholarship: Two \$500 scholarships have been awarded to: **Logan Rodowicz**, (sponsored by LI ABATE member **Vincent Rodowicz**) and **Tara Boyle**, (sponsored by LI ABATE member **Joy Devine**). We congratulate these two recipients, and wish them much success in their future endeavors.

Port Jefferson Parking: LI ABATE has been renting 50 parking spots in the Town of Brookhaven parking lot in order to provide free and unlimited parking for motorcyclists. We have learned that many motorcyclists still did not know of this free motorcycle parking. LI ABATE had business cards made informing motorcyclists of this lot and have been passing them around to motorcyclists in Port Jefferson. Jim recently met with the mayor and chief constable in Port Jefferson, who appreciated LI ABATE's effort in making these cards, and also took some to pass out. Jim also reported that with the exception of some sport bikes reving their engines while riding through town, there were no other complaints voiced to him during this meeting. We continue to urge all motorcyclists to ride respectfully through town.

Motorcycle Only Checkpoints: On June 12, a motorcycle only checkpoint on the eastbound LIE by SCPD was reported to LI ABATE. (Jim purposefully received a ticket at this MOC in effort to protest MOCs in court). Previously, LI ABATE had an agreement with the SCPD to end motorcycle only checkpoints. Since then, however, a new commissioner and new administrators have been in command. Jim spoke in front of the Suffolk County Public Safety Committee, after hearing that a motorcyclist was chased by police for not stopping at this checkpoint. He informed the committee of past agreements made with the police department as well as informing them that federal funding is no longer permitted for such checkpoints.

Suffolk County Legislator, Kate Browning, chair of this committee, Police Commissioner, Tim Sini, and Chief of Department Cameron have since met with Jim to discuss this matter. Commissioner Sini stated that there was no intentional harassment of motorcyclists intended. He went on to state that there are three areas of focus which he would like to address: illegal drugs, illegal handguns and traffic fatalities. He believed that MOC's would reduce traffic fatalities. The Commissioner said that he was unaware of LI ABATE's position on MOC's and further stated that he understood our point of view. Conversations with SCPD will continue. LI ABATE will continue to seek to end these checkpoints through motorcycle profiling legislation in Suffolk County.

Court Cases: Ndala, the driver who hit and killed past vice-president Tom Heissenbuttel, was presented with a 3-6 year plea deal. Regina Heissenbuttel, Tom's widow, along with LI ABATE, did not find this plea deal tolerable. Attorney, Dan Rodgers, spoke to Judge Braslow on behalf of LI ABATE, resulting is the revocation of the 3-6 year plea deal and the offering of a 4-8 year plea deal. Attorney Dan Rodgers stated that the presence of LI ABATE at these court proceedings made the difference in the revocation of the lighter plea deal. The defendant has not accepted this new deal. He must answer Thursday, August 11, in criminal court, Riverhead. We are asking that any members who are available, to be present at this proceeding. Ndala will also be in court August 25 in Central Islip, appearing before Judge Lozito for violating his parole.
