# **PRESIDENT**

The Motorcycle Riders Foundation (MRF) held its annual "Meeting Of The Minds" conference September 22-25<sup>th</sup> in Oklahoma City. There were 40 Motorcycle Rights Organizations (MRO's) in attendance. Mike Lauro and I attend on behalf of Long Island ABATE. We had a great ride there, he rode the northern route and I rode the southern route and both got there within a few hours of each other. On the way there I stopped in Little Rock Arkansas and had the privilege of having dinner and spending the night with great people Fred & Karla of ABATE of Arkansas! Mike and I arrived on Thursday and attended the opening meeting in which every MRO representative takes 2 minutes to explain what your MRO is doing in your state. I used the opportunity to explain what we are doing in the court system and how we are influencing cases when people harm motorcyclists. I think it went over well with the other MRO's and I was thrilled that 6 separate MRO reps pulled me aside over the next 2 days to ask how they should go about doing the same thing in their state? As you know, I'm no expert on the subject but I shared our methods and suggested some things that might help them. They all appeared excited about trying it when they get back to their state. My goal is to get MRO's all across the country to get involved in the courts and I think this was a positive first step. Mike and I spent the following days attending seminars separately so that we obtained twice the amount of info, and then shared what we learned with each other. The guest speaker on Saturday (besides a State Senator) was **Double D** from Washington who was responsible for getting the first anti profiling bill for motorcyclists passed in Washington State. He is a very dynamic and smart motorcycle activist. It's always exciting to hear him lobby the motorcycle community to stand together and pass pro motorcycle legislation. The highlight for me was seeing **Paul Landers** again! I have been working with Paul for 4 years regarding the US Defenders / C.O.I.R. program. Paul was the National Lt. Commander of the program and was instrumental in helping me establish C.O.I.R. (Coalition Of Independent Riders) in New York. Unfortunately, Paul is one of the innocent victims that were arrested in the Waco fiasco on May 15, 2015, when 177 people were initially arrested and held on \$1,000,000.00 bond, simply because he was present at a COC (Coalition Of Clubs) political meeting! He is free on bail and has returned to the role of a motorcyclist activist on a national level, even though he is facing a trial that is punishable by 20years – LIFE! That's dedication!!! I think Mike's highlight was meeting an awesome couple Quentin & Lotus from ABATE of Oklahoma who volunteered to help LI ABATE apply for a NYS grant! We were blown away by their incredibly generous offer! This is a prime example of the benefits of networking with other MRO's! I would also like to thank **ABATE of Oklahoma** for hosting this year's event, you did an outstanding job! And thank you to **Hardtail**, the **President of the MRF** for signing up as a member of LI ABATE! I appreciate it very much!

Our next meeting on October 11<sup>th</sup> is being held at a different location because we anticipate over 200 members in attendance while we disburse the **\$80,000.00** that we raised for our local Veterans. The meeting will be held at the **Centereach VFW** and there will be a free hot buffet at 7:00pm. It is also the opening of nominations for next year's officers of Long Island ABATE, so make sure you attend either this month's meeting or next month, in order to be eligible to run for office! I hope you are available to join us!

Single File Arm and index finger extended straight up.



Double File Arm with index and middle finger extended straight up.



Comfort Stop Forearm extended, fist clenched with short up and down motion,



Refreshment Stop Fingers closed, thumb to mouth.



Turn Signal On Open and close hand with fingers and thumb extended.



Pull Off Arm positioned as for right turn, forearm swung toward shoulder.



Cops Ahead Tap on top of helmet with open palm down.



Fuel Arm out to side pointing to tank with finger extended.



# September 2016 Minutes



LI ABATE membership meeting 9-13-16, Ronkonkoma, NY

BBQ before the meeting. Thank you to Joe, Claudia, Jackie and Mike for doing all of the cooking.

7:38 Meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance

Welcome new members and guests.

A special welcome to **Jack Monti**, and his wife **Josephine**. Jack was involved in a serious motorcycle accident on Rt 25 and Rt 112 in Coram, when a taxi driver ran a red light and broadsided Jack on his motorcycle. Jack was very seriously injured. Members of LI ABATE gave Jack a motorcycle escort home from the hospital, after a lengthy stay. Jack thanked those who escorted him and explained how much it meant to him. **Attny. Mike Della**, who is representing Jack, also praised LI ABATE members for uplifting Jack and escorting him home.

Minutes for the August 2016 membership meeting were published in the September newsletter.

Motion 26-2016: Motion to accept August 2016 membership meeting minutes as published in the September newsletter. (Seconded) All in favor.

**Treasurer's Report:** Detailed income and expenditures were reported. *Bill also thanked all who are contributing to the veteran's appreciation fund. All donations will be quadrupled.* 

Motion 27-2016: Motion to accept treasury report. (Seconded) All in favor.

#### **Committee Reports**

Membership: Currently, LI ABATE has 1650+ members. All membership renewals expiring in September have been mailed out. It is imperative that members renew and that we keep our membership numbers up. We are also encouraging all members to recruit new members, as the more members we have, the more effective we can be when we meet with public officials. Membership pins will no longer be mailed, in effort to save on mailing costs. A coupon will be included with your membership renewal, which can be exchanged for a pin at any membership meeting or LI ABATE booth. If anyone continues to have problems receiving e-mail updates, please see Jackie or Nancy and your e-mail address will be corrected.

**Nancy / Website:** Our website is up and running again. Past and current newsletters are posted on our website. If anyone has pictures or articles they wish to have posted on the website or newsletter, please send to Nancy.

Mike / Public Relations: Mike is working on putting together a motorcycle safety course, along with Don Gomo, Empire State Motorcycle Safety Education Program and Steve Bertinelli, On the Road Again, an MSF state organized motorcycle training school. This course will offer advanced rider skills with a discount to all LI ABATE members. The course will be approx. 5 hours and, if the interest is there, will be held in October at Suffolk County Community College. Participants will receive a 10% insurance discount upon completion of this course. Additionally, for those riding with a permit, a road test waiver upon completion of this course can be received. Mike reported that News12 did cover the escort ride home for Jack Monti, and was also happy to report that Governor Cuomo, wore a LI ABATE / Watch for Motorcycles bracelet on the 9-11 Tribute Ride.

Doreen / Legislative Liaison: Senator Robach, chair of the transportation committee, drafted legislation to include motorcycle safety in defensive driver courses. Doreen went on to speak of exhaust pipe modification legislation. Marty, Mike and Dale have volunteered to assist Doreen with this legislation. Currently any exhaust modification, even if modification remains under the NYS required decibel level, is against the law. Language stating exhaust pipes may not be modified to exceed 86 decibels, equal to automobiles, will be included in the proposed legislation. Doreen is getting this legislation ready for the new Senate / Assembly session. Doreen also passed around a petition opposing the rule allowing E15 fuel, which is harmful to small engines, such as a motorcycle engine, and may void the motorcycle warranty.

**Kathy / Products:** Kathy has been running great sales on merchandise at membership meetings. All current LI ABATE products are being sold for \$10. Kathy also has patches for the Veterans Appreciation Run, Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Run and yearly rockers. On a side note, Kathy was very happy to see a wide array of LI ABATE shirts being worn by members at recent court proceedings.

#### **Old Business**

Motorcycle Only Checkpoints: Suffolk County Legislator, Kate Browning, chair of the Suffolk County Public Safety Committee, Police Commissioner, Tim Sini, and Chief of Department Cameron have met with Jim to discuss the matter of motorcycle only checkpoints.

Commissioner Sini stated that there was no intentional harassment of motorcyclists intended. and believed that MOC's would reduce traffic fatalities. The Commissioner said that he was unaware of LI ABATE's position on MOC's and further stated that he understood our point of view. Conversations with SCPD will continue. LI ABATE will continue to seek to end these checkpoints through motorcycle profiling legislation in Suffolk County.

#### **Court Cases:**

Sabelo Ndala, the driver who hit and killed past vice-president Tom Heissenbuttel, will be

sentenced to 4-8 years on 9/28 in Riverhead, Judge Braslow's courtroom. We ask any members who may be available, to please attend this proceeding. (Attorney Dan Rodgers stated that the presence of LI ABATE at these court proceedings made the difference in the revocation of the 3-6 year plea deal and the offering of a 4-8 year plea deal). Ndala will also be in court 9/30 in Central Islip, appearing before Judge Lozito for violating his parole. LI ABATE will be asking for additional time due to Ndala's new conviction and total disregard for his previous punishment. Again, we encourage members to attend.

Yoneyama, the driver who hit and seriously injured motorcyclist **Ron Starke**, is scheduled to appear before Judge Comacho, 9/23 in Central Islip. We ask LI ABATE members for their attendance as well in support for Ron.

Edward Okon will be in court 9/27, before Judge Dunne in Central Islip. He is being charged with DWI, resulting in the fatality of motorcyclist, **Tomasz Myszke**.

LI ABATE member, Dale Solomon, who is an administrative law judge and motorcyclist, reported that the Department of Motor Vehicles conducts safety hearings in any accident resulting in a fatality, when there is no criminality The administrative law judge has the right to revoke or suspend a driver's license. (If an arrest was made, cases are heard in criminal court). Dale will look into a way that these cases can be tracked.

Morgan, American Legion Riders, spoke of one of his club members, **Danno Lenley**, who was in an extremely serious motorcycle accident after a driver made a u-turn in front of him. This appears to be an accident, as there are no pending charges. Morgan reported that Danno is still in the hospital and thanked all for their prayers.

**Golf Outing:** LI ABATE sponsored a hole at the 2nd Annual New York Sportscene Children's Foundation Celebrity Golf Classic. LI ABATE offered a 2016 Road King to the first golfer who gets a hole in one at the LI ABATE designated hole. **Oakdale Harley** delivered and set up the motorcycle on the green. We obtained an insurance policy covering the cost of this motorcycle through **Specialized Insurance**. Unfortunately, although one golfer came very close, there was no winner of this motorcycle. All proceeds from this event will benefit children's charities.

**Radio Sponsorship:** A member of LI ABATE, **Tom Schilaro**, hosts the radio show *Your Island*, Monday – Friday from 12-2pm, on LI Talk Radio 103.9. Jim has been a frequent guest on this show, speaking about a variety of motorcyclist's issues. LI ABATE is now a sponsor of this show. Tom promotes LI ABATE during each show and urges others to join.




