

## SAFETY OFFICER OFFICER OFFICER

This month I would like to write about Group Riding Safety

My intention is to have you think about group riding. It utilizes a different set of skills then riding alone. Also it is different than a large group ride on a run you will do for charity.

Hold a quick tail board meeting in the olden days the wagon would have a tail board where the group could gather around and have a brief discussion or meeting on the work ahead.

Discuss who is riding where in the group. The **leader** is in charge of being alert letting the group be aware of road hazards that are coming up in the roadway. To be a leader a rider must be able to set a pace that everyone in the group can follow safely. The **sweep rider** should be in communication with the leader keeping the pace and watching the group. This rider's duty is to keep an eye on the riders in front of him/ her. This should also be a rider with a fair amount of experience. If something were to happen (a fall, mechanical failure, etc) to a rider near the back of the group, the chase rider will be there to deal with the situation. A group of no more than ten is preferred modern data will show smaller groups are even better.

Be prepared with a full tank of gas and an empty bladder. Have the proper riding gear that is appropriate for the ride. In the springtime you might need three seasons riding gear. Temperatures range from the thirty's in the morning to the seventies in the afternoon. Being too cold or too hot leads to fatigue

If you are a lone rider type like I am you enjoy the scenery and taking in the great views the road has to offer. When riding with a group you want to pay more attention to your riding and the groups riding. This will ensure that you and the group arrives to the destination and home safely and in one piece.

Stager your riders when you are on the interstate. A staggered formation is a good riding practice. Going through villages, towns or curvy roads, or getting on and off highways you might want to choose single file.

The more experienced rider, the lead and the sweep should keep in mind the less experienced riders. Whether it is due to fatigue or rest stops maybe even a gas stop keep the newbee rider in mind.

Group riding is not ten people challenging each other in a competition. It's about ten individuals working as a single group riding and arriving safely home.

We all know the two second rule and the one second rule. This doesn't mean we always should ride like that. The road condition, rider experience and other reason will dictate the groups speed and distance between each motorcycle.

Please check your motorcycles or bring to a motorcycle mechanic. Don't just fire it up and ride away. Remember TCLOCKS and perform them.

You will thank yourself later when you get home safely ride after ride throughout the riding season.

Registrations are due and know which month your NYS inspections are due?

Keep safe! Ride smart! Watch for the other guy/gal! Ride like you are invisible to automobiles.

### March 2017 Minutes (Nassau Meeting)

LI ABATE membership meeting 3-21-17, Massapequa, NY

March membership meeting in Ronkonkoma cancelled due to weather.

7:54 Meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance

Minutes for the February 2017 membership meeting were published in the March 2017 newsletter.

Motion 7-2017: Motion to accept February 2017 membership meeting minutes as published in the March 2017 newsletter. (Seconded) All in favor.

**Treasurer's Report:** Bill was not present at tonight's meeting. Jim gave the treasurer's report which included recent income and expenditures

Motion 8 -2017: Motion to accept treasury report. (Seconded) All in favor.

#### **Committee Reports**

Membership: April is a large membership renewal month. It is imperative that members renew and that we keep our membership numbers up. It is the only way we can be effective when we meet with public officials in protecting the rights and safety of motorcyclists. Please note that the LI ABATE board meets 2x/month, so processing membership applications and renewals may take some time. If you are not receiving LI ABATE newsletters or e-mails, please let Jackie or Nancy know and the e-mail data base will be updated.

Nancy / Newsletter: A link was sent out to members for the March 2017 newsletter.

**Nancy / Website:** Nancy continues to update the website. A new events calendar is up and membership renewals are once again working on the website. Information regarding the upcoming Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Run is on the website along with pre-registration (pre-registration discount \$15 rider, \$10 passenger).

Mike / Public Relations: Mike is seeking media coverage for our Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Run, which will be in April. He also reached out to BOCES to inquire if students would be available to videograph this event. Suffolk County Executive Steve Bellone and Suffolk County Legislators have been invited to attend press conference before the run. Mike reached out to Oakdale Harley to inquire if LI ABATE can set up a booth at their open house events. The first of these events will be Saturday 3/25 at Oakdale Harley. He, and other board members, presented Oakdale Harley with a plaque in appreciation for their support of LI ABATE.

Mike / Legislative Officer: Mike has picked up the legislation regarding exhaust pipes, with language in this legislation stating that altered exhaust pipes may not exceed current accepted

decibel levels. Mike has been in contact with a representative from *Vance and Hines*, who was unaware that NYS law does not allow for the altering of stock exhaust system. Mike will inquire about literature pertaining to decibel levels on their exhaust pipes. Members discussed getting exhaust pipe manufacturing companies, along with AMA and MRF involved in this legislation.

**Kathy / Products:** Products (crew sweatshirts, zippered sweatshirts, hoodies, t-shirts) are available for purchase at all membership meetings. New embroidered knit LI ABATE hats are now available for \$15. Kathy also proposed a membership challenge. Members who sign up 5 new members will receive a crew neck sweatshirt + 1 year free membership renewal. Members who sign up 10 new members will receive a crew neck sweatshirt + 2 year free membership renewal. Members who sign up 20 new members will receive a sweatshirt of their choosing + 5 year free membership renewal. Challenge is due at the April membership meeting.

#### **Old Business**

**LI ABATE 2017 Motorcyclist Handbook:** Nancy is now working on the 2017 Motorcyclist Handbook. The deadline for advertising in this handbook has been reached. The handbooks will be sent to print and will be available at our Awareness Run in April. The centerfold of this handbook will once again list bike runs and events.

**LI ABATE Scholarship Fundraiser:** We had approximately 60 participants at our *paint night* fundraiser, at the Backstage Pass, Ronkonkoma. Over \$1,000 was raised, which will go toward the 2017 LI ABATE Scholarship fund. **Andrea**, our volunteer coordinator, has graciously named LI ABATE as the recipient of a fundraiser she hosts with psychic Janet Russell. This will be held at Villa Monaco's. Tickets are \$75per person.

Court Cases: LI ABATE continues to monitor cases where a motorcyclist is seriously injured by a motorist. This is taken very seriously by the District Attorney and the presiding Judge on the case, as any advocacy group in attendance makes a difference in court proceedings and outcomes. In the case of Yoneyama, the driver who hit and seriously injured motorcyclist Ron Starke, Yoneyama pled guilty to DWI and will be sentenced 3/23 @ Riverhead in the courtroom of Judge Cohen. Members are encouraged to attend in support of Ron. An e-mail reminder will be sent out. The Brotherhood of United Bikers asked LI ABATE to become involved in a case in Connecticut, where a woman, accused of DWI, drove into a group of 18 motorcyclists, resulting in death and serious injuries to motorcyclists. LI ABATE and CMRA (Connecticut Motorcycle Riders Association) attended court hearing, where the driver received an \$800,000 bail. CMRA will continue to monitor this case.

**2017 St. Patrick's Day Parade, Rocky Point:** The **Rocky Point VFW** and **Patriot Guard Riders** invited LI ABATE to participate in the annual St. Patrick's Day Parade, Sunday 3/12. This year, motorcycles lead the parade. Although the weather was <u>very cold</u>, motorcyclists did attend.

#### **New Business**

**Long Island Needs A Dragstrip:** Jim / LI ABATE is a member of the Long Island Needs a Dragstrip Committee in effort to provide motorcyclists with a safe place to race. A task force has now been established consisting of two members of this committee and two Suffolk County Legislators. The goal is to develop a motorsports park.

**Motorcycle Awareness Road Signs:** We have 4 x 4 motorcycle awareness signs to be posted on county roads for the motorcycle season. We are looking for volunteers to help post these signs. Also if anyone knows of property where we could post additional 4 x 4 signs with permission, in Suffolk and in Nassau, please let board know. In addition, 4' x 8' motorcycle awareness signs will be posted in front of all police precincts in May.

**Count Motorcycles:** LI ABATE wants to encourage all drivers and passengers to play "count motorcycles" while on the road. LI ABATE member, **Karen Wirth**, along with member **Bill Forrester**, developed this idea into a game, which they had printed on pads. These pads will be given out at the Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Run.

#### LI ABATE Run / Event List

April 2 - Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Run in conjunction with Full Throttle Magazine.

This year we will be inviting people who have been impacted in a motorcycle accident, due to a driver's carelessness, to share their stories. We are hoping that the media will then push the motorcycle awareness message. The run will begin at the Dennison Bldg., Hauppauge.

Registration will begin at 9am, with a press conference at 11am. Local political officials will again be invited. Bike blessings will be offered by Bikers for Christ Motorcycle Ministry. The run will go to Backstage Pass, Ronkonkoma. All proceeds from this run will go toward our 2017 Motorcycle Safety and Awareness campaign.

June 11 - Veterans Appreciation Run. The run will begin at the Riverhead Elks and end in Montauk. All proceeds from this run will be <u>quadrupled</u> and given to local veterans organizations. Kathy Pfeil has gotten the 82<sup>nd</sup> Battalion Military Band to play at Montauk. A bugler will also be present to play Taps.
