Old Business

LI ABATE Motorcyclist's Handbook is now available for the 2017 riding season. The centerfold of this handbook lists motorcycle runs for the season. Nancy will be sending out outstanding invoices this week.

Count Motorcycles: LI ABATE wants to encourage all drivers and passengers to play "count motorcycles" while on the road. LI ABATE member, **Karen Wirth**, along with member **Bill Forrester**, developed this idea into a game, which they had printed on pads. These pads were given out at the Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Run, and are available a membership meetings and LI ABATE booths.

Sgt. John Barbato Award: LI ABATE was presented with this special award by **Project9Line** for our "significant support of project9line's mission". *Project 9 Line is an organization that helps veterans cope with PTSD.*

New Business

LI ABATE Scholarship: Long Island ABATE Scholarship, which is dedicated to the memory of **Stavros Dalambakis**, and all of our fallen brothers and sisters, is available to the children / grandchildren of LI ABATE members. This year, two \$750 scholarships will be awarded. One scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who will be attending college / vocational school, and one scholarship will be awarded to a currently matriculating college / vocational student. Scholarship applications will be available on the LI ABATE website. Our paint night fundraiser, at the Backstage Pass, Ronkonkoma was a great success in which over \$1,000 was raised. In addition, **Andrea**, our volunteer coordinator, has graciously named LI ABATE as the recipient of a fundraiser she hosts with psychic Janet Russell. Andrea will be donating her proceeds toward this scholarship fund. This fundraiser will be held at Villa Monaco's, 4/27, 6:30-9:30. Tickets are \$75per person, limited to 40 participants.

Motorcycle Awareness Road Signs: We have 4×4 motorcycle awareness signs to be posted on county roads for the motorcycle season. We are looking for volunteers to help post these signs. Volunteers will meet at Cathedral Pines County Park, Middle Island on May 6^{th} . Also if anyone knows of property where we could post additional 4×4 signs with permission, in Suffolk and in Nassau, please let board know. In addition, $4' \times 8'$ motorcycle awareness signs will be posted in front of all police precincts in May.

Port Jefferson Parking: LI ABATE has been renting 50 parking spots in the Town of Brookhaven parking lot in order to provide **free** and **unlimited** parking for motorcyclists. We will do this again for the 2017 riding season. This costs LI ABATE \$2500 for the year. Through the efforts of **Tommy Schaeffer, President of the Business Improvement District of Port Jefferson,** BID has supported this endeavor and has reimbursed LI ABATE \$2000. While we do not mandate that motorcycles park in this designated area, we do encourage motorcyclists to take advantage of this free, unlimited parking space since parking on Main St. is strictly limited to 30 minutes (they do chalk tires).

Motorcycle Raffle: A discussion ensued about the possibility of LI ABATE raffling off a new motorcycle. LI ABATE member **Warren** has volunteered to look into details.

Motorcycle Safety and Awareness Run in conjunction with Full Throttle Magazine, was held April 2 and was a great success. Approximately 500 motorcycles were present. We are grateful to Jack Monti and Regina Heisenbuttel for sharing their stories about how their lives have been forever affected due to the negligence of a driver. Suffolk County Executive Steve Bellone spoke highly of LI ABATE, and our mission to keep motorcyclists safe. FIOS and News 12 covered the run. In addition, Lance, a BOCES student, videographed the run, and will edit and make into a film. Suffolk County Executive Steve Bellone also had the run videotaped, and will

post it on his *Facebook* page. We would like to thank **Bikers of Christ MM** for the blessing of each bike, the **Suffolk County Police Department**, **5**th **Precinct** for their assistance escorting the run, and **Andrea** for organizing all of the volunteers for this run. All funds raised on this run will go toward LI ABATE's 2017, motorcycle safety and awareness campaign. Pictures from the run will be posted on our Facebook community page and website.
