David "Double D" Devereaux was the guest speaker at June's general

meeting! He is the founder of the Motorcycle Profiling Project which is a national organization that identifies and works to resolve the profiling of motorcyclists around the country. He was instrumental in achieving the first anti profiling legislation for motorcyclists in Washington State and also assisted Maryland in becoming the 2nd state to pass similar legislation. I have networked with him in several states for 5 years and it was always my hope to bring him to Long Island so he could share his knowledge and help motivate us in order to better protect ourselves against profiling. I can't tell you how happy I am that it has finally taken place! We started with a brief business meeting and then we welcomed our guests. First **Peter from HAMC LI** Charter briefly addressed the membership and then introduced our guest speaker from Washington. Double D went on to explain the history of his Outsiders MC in Tacoma Washington. He also explained how the MC was targeted by local law enforcement and about the tragedy that resulted. He explained that because of the profiling that was systematically taking place against his club, it enabled him and his MC to finally get legislation approved unanimously that protects all motorcyclists in his state. He also explained the importance of reporting profiling when it happens to us. Profiling complaint forms can be filled out on his website at www.motorcycleprofilingproject.com. When he finished addressing the membership, it was great to see that everyone appreciated hearing what he had to say, as they gave him a standing ovation! I would have been satisfied that he was able to address our members only, but I was ecstatic that the HAMC LI Charter invited Double D and myself to address representatives from the majority of Motorcycle Clubs at their clubhouse the following night! I'm happy to say that the MC members were just as impressed with him as we were the night before! Double D has also prepared a nearly 50 page document specifically for us in NY which includes statistics and data necessary to help us obtain similar legislation in NY!

It was a very successful visit!! ©

SAFETY OFFICER

I hope everyone is enjoying the 2017 riding season. We are into the summer months already. This month I want to write about the roadway. If you are heading south keep in mind you might be going into areas where the air temperature could approach or go above 100 degrees. As an example a 95 degree day gets the asphalt temperature to rise between 120 degrees to 140 degrees. Due to the heat, the vehicles we share the road with are dropping oil, gasoline, water, antifreeze etc. on to the roadway. All of this plus the hot asphalt makes for a slippery surface. You might want to adjust your riding style. Be a little more conservative with the throttle, cornering, lean angle and leave more time for braking. Just like in the rain stay out of the middle track of the lane. This is especially true while stopping at intersections. Use the left track or right track for stopping and look where you are placing your feet down. Ride safe have fun!

Don't forget T-CLOCKS before you ride.

T-CLOCK

Don't forget to perform these basic checks on your ride.

TIRES-check your air pressure, the side walls and treads for cracks and wear.

CONTROL-check your controls clutch and brake levers, accelerator cables, hoses.

LIGHTS-check Headlamps, directional lights, four way flashers, battery check fluid level add distilled water if low.

OIL-check Engine oil, brake fluid, gear oil, gas tank for rust, gas filter, brake fluid, if equipped coolant.

Chassis-check swingarm for lubrication and front forks and rear shocks for leaks, check belts, or chain drives.

Kickstands- check for cracks broken or loose springs, bent stand safety switch works on side stand. Check center stand if equipped.

You can go to a trained mechanic. They are easy to find in our Long Island Abate Handbook or in Full Throttle Magazine. This is a very basic list you can see a more detailed list on line.

Welcome new members and guests.

Minutes for the May 2017 membership meeting were published in the June 2017 newsletter.

Motion 16-2017: Motion to accept May 2017 membership meeting minutes as published in the June 2017 newsletter. (Seconded) All in favor.

Treasurer's Report: Detailed income and expenditures were reported.

Motion 17-2017: Motion to accept treasury report. (Seconded) All in favor.

Committee Reports

Jackie / Membership: Memberships can be renewed by mail, online or at a membership meeting. (Membership dues is \$20 per year, \$80 for 5 years or \$10 per year, up to 25 years, for lifetime memberships.) Jackie urges applicants to please print clearly on membership applications. It is imperative that members renew and that we keep our membership numbers up. It is the only way we can be effective when we meet with public officials in protecting the rights and safety of motorcyclists.

Nancy / Newsletter: If you are not receiving LI ABATE newsletters or e-mails via mail chimp, please let Nancy know and the e-mail data base will be updated. Nancy also encourages any motorcycle event flyers be sent to her for a free one month publication in our newsletter.

Nancy / Website: Scholarship applications can be printed from our website. Campout tickets are also available on our website. Tickets are \$30 in advance and \$40 the day of our campout. Nancy is again accepting video clips from motorcyclists following the format: *Hi, my name is*____. I am a(n) occupation. And I ride a motorcycle. As in the past, clips should include motorcyclists in their work attire, then a clip of them on their motorcycles.

Kathy / Products: There are only a few 2017 Veterans Appreciation Run t-shirts left @ \$15. Rockers, for any year, are available @ 5 / \$1. Kathy also stated that \$1,940 worth of merchandise was sold at the Veterans Appreciation Run. She thanks **Sue** and **Peggy** for their assistance at the products table. In addition, \$500 worth of new and renewed memberships was taken in, half of which will be donated to the Veterans fund.

Old Business

Nassau membership meetings continue to be held on the third Tuesday of each month @ 7:30. Meetings are held at the Marine Corp. League Building 99, New York Avenue, Massapequa.

LI ABATE Scholarship: Long Island ABATE Scholarship, which is dedicated to the memory of **Stavros Dalambakis**, and all of our fallen brothers and sisters, is available to the children / grandchildren of LI ABATE members. This year, two \$750 scholarships will be awarded. One scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who will be attending college / vocational school, and one scholarship will be awarded to a currently matriculating college / vocational student. Scholarship applications are available on the LI ABATE website.

Motorcycle Awareness Road Signs: Jim thanks all those who volunteered to post the 4 x 4 motorcycle awareness signs on county roads for the motorcycle season. If anyone knows of additional properties where we could post 4 x 4 signs with permission, in Suffolk and in Nassau, please let board know. We have purchased the materials to make 4 additional signs.

Court Case: Motorcyclist **Chris Vorsik**, was killed on College Road in Selden by an alleged drunk driver. LI ABATE continues to monitor this case. The next scheduled court hearing will be held July 14th in Central Islip.

USDA Educational and Safety Seminar: Jim and Kathy presented a safety training course about motorcycle awareness to all attendees. The presentation was well received.

Town of Brookhaven Motorcycle Awareness Signs: Brookhaven Town has again posted motorcycle awareness signs in each council district. Each sign posted has the Councilperson's name along with LI ABATE. A press conference is being coordinated to show that LI ABATE and local municipalities are working together for motorcycle awareness. *Thank you to Kathy Pfeil for helping this to occur again this year.*

NYS Governor's Traffic Safety Committee Grant request has been successfully submitted, thanks to Lotus from ABATE of Oklahoma. Mike and Jim met her last year while attending an MRF Conference in Oklahoma. She offered to help us write a grant and ended up writing a 51 page grant. LI ABATE is requesting funds for educational and awareness materials as well as funds to spread the motorcycle awareness message to the public sector through various media outlets. After amending the original application, LI ABATE was awarded \$29,400.

Your Island Radio Show: LI ABATE is once again sponsoring *Your Island* radio show with host **Tom Schillaro**, who is also a LI ABATE member, for 10 weeks. The radio show airs Monday through Friday on 103.9, from 12:00pm – 2:00pm. Tomorrow at noon, Jim, along with **leading motorcyclist activist, Double D**, will be discussing motorcyclist's issues, including motorcycle profiling.

Riverhead Polish Hall Annual Steak Dinner will be held tomorrow, June 14, Flag Day. Tickets are \$20 each. LI ABATE has 4 tables. Last year all raffle money proceeds were donated to LI ABATE's *Veterans Appreciation Fund*. This donation totaled \$2500, which became \$10,000 with the matching funds from three private donors.

New Business

Guest Speaker – Peter, HAMC Long Island Charter introduced Double D, who is one of the leading motorcyclist advocates in the country. Double D spoke about motorcycle profiling, which he said is an epidemic in NYS. Double D spoke of being a 2nd generation member of the Outsiders MC in Tacoma Washington. He witnessed repeatedly, the targeting and abusive profiling of his father and club brothers by law enforcement. He felt this was a motorcycle club issue, but later found that this was an issue to all motorcyclists. This propelled him to speak about motorcycle profiling and ultimately to help get an anti-profiling law passed unanimously in his state of Washington in 2011. He offered his expertise in the state of Maryland to get an anti profiling bill passed, in 2016, without a single "no" vote. It is now time for all motorcyclists in New York State to get behind an anti profiling bill. Double D has already written a 40+ page bill specific to NYS. He has offered consultation on how to get this bill to move forward and has also offered to testify before a legislative hearing. It is our mission to gain legislative support for this bill. In addition, Double D suggests we begin a grassroots media campaign, telling our experiences of motorcycle profiling, in effort to build a pattern of evidence in NYS and ultimately a pattern of evidence nationally. We also encourage you to participate in his National Motorcycle Profiling Survey, which has become the backbone of the MRF's effort to support and lobby for a National Profiling Bill.

Thank you Double D, for all that you do for the motorcycle community.

Motion 18-2017: Motion to adjourn. (Seconded) All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 8:51.








