

# September 2017 Minutes

LI ABATE membership meeting 9-12-17, Commack, NY

Membership meeting was held at the CSEA meeting hall. The Ronkonkoma meeting location was unavailable as it was primary day and that location is a polling place.

Heroes and salads served before the meeting.

7:36 Meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance. Moment of Silence in remembrance of the September 11, 2001 terror attacks. *LI ABATE member, Rich, who was working in Tower Two that day, told of his experience.* 

Welcome new members and guests.

Minutes for the August 2017 membership meeting were sent out with the September 2017 newsletter.

Motion 25-2017: Motion to accept August 2017 membership meeting minutes which were sent with the September 2017 newsletter. (Seconded) All in favor.

**Treasurer's Report:** Detailed income and expenditures were reported. Thank you to **Attorney Mitch Proner** for his very generous donation of \$5,000 to sponsor our campout. Bill also spoke about the Veterans Appreciation Fund. He thanked <u>all</u> who generously contributed to this fund. Our total to date Is over \$120,000! The list of recipient veteran organizations is being finalized, and funds will be distributed at our October 10th membership meeting, which will be held at the Centereach VFW.

Motion 26-2017: Motion to accept treasury report. (Seconded) All in favor.

#### **Committee Reports**

Jackie / Membership: Membership is approaching 2000. Memberships can be renewed by mail, online or at a membership meeting. (Membership dues is \$20 per year, \$80 for 5 years or \$10 per year, up to 25 years, for lifetime memberships.) Jackie urges applicants to please print clearly on membership applications. It is imperative that members renew and that we keep our membership numbers up. It is the only way we can be effective when we meet with public officials in protecting the rights and safety of motorcyclists.

**Nancy / Newsletter:** If you are not receiving LI ABATE newsletters or e-mails via mail chimp, please let Nancy know and the e-mail data base will be updated. Nancy lists all upcoming LI ABATE booths in the newsletter. *If anyone wishes to volunteer at one of these booths, please let Nancy know.* Nancy also encourages any motorcycle event flyers be sent to her for a free one month publication in our newsletter.

**Mike / Safety Officer:** Mike is compiling a list of traffic lights that will not change for motorcycles. Mike asks anyone who knows of a location where motorcycles do not trip the light to please let him know. Mike is also working on a list of locations where potholes need to be addressed. Again, please let Mike know of such locations.

**Kathy / Products:** Long sleeved LI ABATE shirts and sweatshirts will be available at the October membership meeting.

#### **Old Business**

Nassau membership meetings continue to be held on the third Tuesday of each month @ 7:30. Meetings are held at the Marine Corp. League Building 99, New York Avenue, Massapequa. Meetings are a recap of business discussed at the official monthly meeting held in Ronkonkoma.

**Court Case:** LI ABATE has been monitoring the case of motorcyclist **Chris Voresik**, who was fatally injured on College Road in Selden. A plea deal, which has been accepted by the victim's family, has been reached, as there appeared to be fault on both sides.

#### **New Business**

**Motorcycle Accident:** Two motorcycles rear ended a car on Boyle Road in Selden. One motorcyclist left the scene. The second motorcyclist went down, and ultimately passed away at the hospital. It was later learned that these two motorcyclists were part of a group of motorcyclists that were riding recklessly for an extended period of time in the Selden, Centereach, Port Jefferson Station area. Jim spoke out against this type of behavior, as it affects the reputation of all motorcyclists.

LI ABATE member, **Lee Lambertson** was riding his motorcycle to work when a driver turned into him. Lee needed surgery on his leg and remains in the hospital. *Lee hesitated going to the hospital due to medical costs. We urge all riders to please talk to their insurance agent about increasing coverage on policy to include medical expenses. Motorcycle Mike has offered to review motorcycle insurance policies to determine if coverage is adequate.* 

**Motorcycle Mike**, a personal injury attorney, has offered a discounted fee from 33% to 25% to all LI ABATE members. He has also offered to donate \$1,000 to the LI ABATE Scholarship Fund from his earnings.

Future LI ABATE meeting locations: The October membership meeting will take place at the Centereach VFW, Horseblock Rd., Centereach. A buffet dinner will be served at 6:30 and we will be disbursing the Veterans Appreciation Funds. Afterward, we will resume the business portion of the membership meeting where nominations for the 2018 LI ABATE Officers will be held. The November membership meeting will be back in Ronkonkoma, where nominations will continue, and elections will be held. Anyone who wishes to be nominated for a board position must be present at the October and / or November meeting. There will be no December meeting.

Your Island Live with Tom Schilaro radio show: (airs on 103.9, weekdays from 12:00 – 2:00.) Suffolk County Police Chief Cameron was on the show discussing how a police officer is assigned to track and collect data on all car accidents. Jim called into the show and explained that most motorcycle accidents occur when a driver turns left in front of the motorcycle. He suggested that LI ABATE and the SCPD work together to collect data regarding this type of accident. This information would be valuable in addressing motorcycle safety.

**Presidents Meeting:** The Presidents of all motorcycle clubs on Long Island meet monthly. Jim will be a guest speaker at their September monthly meeting. Jim is encouraged that more motorcycle clubs are joining and getting involved in LI ABATE.

**WACO Update:** Jury selection in the first trial of those arrested in the incident in Waco, Texas will begin this month. There continues to be much controversy surrounding the events of that day as well as the arrests made. Many motorcyclists who were arrested were motorcyclist advocates and there to discuss motorcyclists' issues. Charges brought against them include conspiracy to commit organized crime with an underlying charge of murder. The objectiveness of the prosecution and of the court proceedings has been questioned.
