Treasurer's Report: Detailed income and expenditures were reported

Motion 2-2020: Motion to accept treasurer's report. (Seconded) All in favor.

#### **Old Business**

LI ABATE Lottery: LI ABATE held a fundraiser based on the NYS evening daily numbers. The lottery ran from July 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019. 397 tickets were sold with an average payout of \$500 per month. *Thank you to George and Debbie Stondell for administering and managing this lottery.* The top lottery ticket sellers were: Karen Wirth 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$100, Griff Wolz, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize \$75, and Sherril Hart 3<sup>rd</sup> prize \$50. LI ABATE will repeat this lottery fundraiser July 2020 through December 2020.

**National Motorcycle Anti-Profiling Bill:** House Resolution 255 fights discrimination of motorcyclists on a national and state level. The MRF lobbied for this all through 2019. There are now 125 cosponsors nationally. The bill has the full support of **Congressman Lee Zeldin,** 

whose name is on the bill. Another "call to action" went out recently via e-mail. A prewritten letter will automatically be forwarded to your congressional representative, asking them to sign on to this bill. Congressman Peter King has not yet signed on to this bill. If your congressional representative has already signed on, then a thank you letter will automatically be forwarded. NYS had the most responders for a "call to action" in the past to get their congressional representatives to sponsor this bill.

**Veterans Appreciation Fund:** The 2020 Veterans Appreciation Fund is underway with a donation jug being passed around. *Through the generosity of the motorcycle community, and our three private benefactors, LI ABATE was able to donate \$160,000 to local veteran organizations in 2019.* 

**Grants:** In 2019, LI ABATE, with approval from the membership, decided to enlist the company *Biz.net / Charity.net* to assist us with grant applications and donation / sponsorship applications. LI ABATE has not yet paid for these services and will follow up with this in 2020.

## **New Business**

**2020 Meeting Location:** Monthly membership meetings will now be held at the Centereach VFW. The rental fee for the meeting room is \$200 per month. *The Ronkonkoma Fire Department, our previous location, has scheduled EMT classes on Tuesday nights and will be renovating their building afterward. We were paying \$150 per month for the use of their meeting room.* 

**LI ABATE 2020 Motorcyclist Handbook:** Nancy will begin working on the 2020 Motorcyclist Handbook. If anyone is interested in advertising, please let Nancy know. Advertising prices remain the same as last year, \$100 for a full-page ad and \$50 for a half-page ad. (If advertising art is needed, an additional \$25 fee will be imposed.) *A calendar of motorcycle runs / events will again be included in the centerfold.* 

**Open Mic Nights:** Long Island ABATE and the Centereach VFW are sponsoring an "Open Mic Night" every Wednesday night from 7:00 – 9:30, in the lounge at the VFW. LI ABATE member, Loriann, from Wildflower and Simple Days, volunteered to run the Open Mic nights. There is a cash bar and food available. Come join us Wednesday nights!

Motorcycle Accident: LI ABATE member, John "Wolfie" Filomena, passed away on December 26<sup>th</sup>. He hit a deer on October 6<sup>th</sup> while riding his motorcycle, and never regained consciousness. LI ABATE member and President of Elmont American Legion Riders Post 1033, Bill Stegman was in a motorcycle accident last week. He is currently in rehab with for his injuries.

**Student Veterans Association:** SVA offers tuition assistance for veterans. Over 500 veterans are enrolled in Suffolk County Community College, taking 12+ credits. (If a veteran takes 12+ credits, they will also receive a housing supplement.) These veterans also coordinate fundraisers for local causes.
