Long Island ABATE has been in many places. We attended the Indian Riders Group of Mineola as well as B.A.C.A's member meeting and spoke about our organization and what we do. Both meetings



went well and were well received. Many of the members were unaware of what we do. By the time we left everyone was aware and appreciated what we do as an organization. We also recruited new members and renewed a few as well. Representatives from Long Island ABATE attended a few club parties as well as the Riders of Fire Bike Blessing where we had the tent set up and although the day was very windy, we managed to have a great day with many people. Also, that day I was able to be part of Team EVA's Marathon motorcycle escort with many other members from ABATE and other organizations. Afterwards I met up with the others at the Bike Blessing. Later in the week a few of us also attended a Narcan training class put on by SCPD at the Elks Lodge in Centereach, it was truly an informative presentation.

Sunday April 21<sup>st,</sup> we attended the Cars and Guitars event at Millers Ale House in Commack, as well as the Middle Country Community Festival on the 27th, and our Awareness Run on the 28<sup>th</sup>, Pictures and stories in next month's newsletter.

Our Awareness Presentations continue to grow, we have added Shoreham Mount Sinai High School to our list as well as Farmingdale. We are now on track to do over 70 classes this year, that equates to over 2400 students reached.

Don't forget to look over your bike or have someone do it for you. Check your Tires (condition, and pressure) Lights, Fluids, and Brakes. Practice when you can, slow maneuvers, braking etc. Also be aware of the road conditions. There are many Potholes out there as well as sand and debris. May is a busy Month for us as well. Along with all the events going on we also have the NCOM Convention in Kansas City Missouri from May 9th until May 12th. This trip is sponsored by Mitch Proner and there we meet with clubs from around the country and discuss each other's concerns and legislative issues. 

Like the Good Samaritan law if you're at a party and someone Overdosing and you call the police even if you're underage and your doing things you should not be doing you will not get in trouble for calling for help 911, Narcan is not dangerous and is easy to use 1 squirt in one nostril and 3 min later the 2<sup>nd</sup> in the other. 






















### New York State Good Samaritan Law

New York now has a 911 Good Samaritan
Law On September 18th, 2011, New York's
911 Good Samaritan law went into effect.
This policy seeks to encourage people to call
911 when witnessing or experiencing an
alcohol or other drug overdose by providing
a limited shield from charge and prosecution
for possession of narcotics, marijuana, and for
minors, alcohol. The policy also provides
limited immunity from arrest when the
witnesses who call 911 or overdose victim
possesses residual or certain amounts of
drugs.






# 100TH ANNIVERSARY LACONIA MOTORCYCLE WEEK RALLY

### **STOP** PRETENDING, and **START** HEARING

Many of us take our good hearing for granted. But the fact is, good hearing is a precious commodity, and our ears deserve a little respect. We need to hear well to enjoy all the nuances of a symphonic masterpiece, or to enjoy a Broadway stage production. We need to hear well in order to communicate, to learn, and to socialize. And we need to hear well to stay safe.

It has been estimated that 28 million Americans suffer from some form of hearing impairment. Auditory deprivation occurs when hearing loss goes untreated over a long period of time. In many cases, the effects of auditory deprivation can be helped by wearing hearing aids, and the earlier you treat your hearing loss, the better your chances are of minimizing this risk.

The best course of action is to consult with an audiologist (a professional specializing in hearing health care) who can perform a complete assessment of your hearing and discuss treatment options that best fit your needs. If a hearing aid is recommended, there are many types and sizes to fit all budgets. Today's digital hearing aid technology is vastly more sophisticated than that of hearing instruments in years past. With features to reduce background noise and improve clarity of speech, digital hearing aids provide a crisp, clear, and more natural sound. Bluetooth connectivity, rechargeability, and tinnitus relief features are now standard in most devices.

Hearing loss is a growing medical condition that needs your attention. It is important to discuss with your physician the symptoms of your hearing loss and its impact on your lifestyle. Answer the following questions to help you decide if a hearing evaluation is needed. Be honest with yourself, because this is about <u>your</u> well-being and quality of life.

- 1. Do you have trouble hearing on the telephone?
- 2. Do you avoid social activities because you cannot hear well and fear you will reply improperly?
- 3. Do others complain that you turn the TV volume too high or do you have trouble understanding the dialogue on the TV?
- 4. Do you have to strain to understand conversation?
- 5. Do you find yourself asking people to repeat themselves?
- 6. Do you have trouble hearing in a noisy background, such as a crowded room or restaurant?
- 7. Do you misunderstand what others are saying and respond inappropriately?
- 8. Do you get confused about the direction sounds come from?
- 9. Do other people seem to mumble or not speak clearly?
- 10. Do you have trouble understanding the speech of women and children?
- 11. Do people get annoyed because you misunderstand what they say?
- 12. Do family members and friends comment about your hearing?

If you answered "Yes" to 3 or more questions, you should speak to an audiologist about scheduling a comprehensive hearing evaluation and share the test results with your physician.


