9/14/24 – Nassau Harley – Donna set up a tent and had help from Joe Mulligan. Day was short and there was not much foot traffic.

9/14/24 – Brotherhood event – Josephine had a tent set up. Event went well. 2 new members were signed up. She spoke with people from the sports biking world about Abate in hopes of signing them up. There was a lot of traffic at the table. A 5-year membership was paid for my Sarah and her husband.

9/21/24 – Indian Larry's – Chris and Josephine were at the event. They got the word out there, street signs were given out. There were no new sign ups. A lot of education. Anna was there as well as DOT were there that we made connections with.

9/26 - 9/29/24 - Meeting of the Minds

-Josephine – met with old friends and new friends were made. There were 43 MC right organizations and each person spoke about what each state is up against in the legislative. In NC and TN there is Bentley's Law – would require the intoxicated driver who killed the parent of a minor to pay a court-determined amount of restitution until the child is 18 years old. -Margaret – Margaret went over what Bentley's Law was and how it came about. In addition to MC Rights Organization they had MC Clubs there as well. Margaret found it very interesting that all the organizations and clubs were getting along.

- **Deb** – Discussed hearing from the top people of MRF and what they're lobbing for. Issue - not getting enough senators and congressman to sign on to these bills. She attended legislative strategy on how to start a bill and get it passed. There was a meeting on Saturday at 7:30pm which was a fast paced MC round table meeting.

- **Nick** – Discussed the next Bikers on the Belt is May 19 and 20th 2025. He brought back a book with information on what other activities other organizations are doing. He went to several sessions and found it very awarding. The 2025 Meeting of the Minds will be in Louisiana and 2026 will be in Milwaukee.

Update from Nick – 10/8/24 was 6th Precinct meeting and the speaker spoke about domestic violence. Inspector went through list of burglaries, firing of gun or riffles, grand larceny, young adults blocked intersection in Miller Place doing donuts. A motorcycle rider was killed during this. A similar incident took place in Patchogue and someone was injured. In Sept 698 crimes

were report including burglary and larceny. There were: 174 arrest; 261 charged; 23 DWI and 1781 tickets written.
