Don't' React Too Quickly

What a whirlwind of events that's going on around us. We barely have a chance to take a breath. We have seen tragedy in so many forms...bike accidents. car accidents, shootings in parking lots, folks hitting folks walking in a parking lot, bikers kicking cars, medical events happening to young children, as well as very healthy folks. I will give advice, occasionally, when asked, about how someone should handle something. I feel that I need to say this. Please, count to 15, not 10. We've gotta slow down a bit friends. Things happen when we react too quickly or don't prepare correctly.

The young are, like we did, speeding out of control, doing dangerous things) and folks are getting badly hurt or dying. Road rage is amazingly high, and 2 bikers died from that recently. I've said this before, but I must repeat myself. **"Tonnage wins."** If a car is giving you a hard time, or driving recklessly, and you're on your bike, let them go. If you're driving and someone behind you wants you to go faster, let them go past you. If you're in a store and someone wants to jump in front of you, let them. We don't know what anyone else is going through (and we don't have to know), and we don't want the possible explosion from someone for an additional 5 minutes of our time. It's easier to react, but with so much stress and division going on these days, something could be misunderstood and become explosive. "Treat others as you would want to be treated." The real golden rule.

We were trained to count to 10 by our parents. Let's increase that to 15. Cooler heads always prevail. There are many verses in the bible about this, but the one that stands out to me is *Proverbs 15:18*. It says, "A hot-tempered man stirs up strife, but the **slow to anger** calms a dispute." Aim to be slow to anger.

Words to think about and hold on to.

God bless you all. May we have a great riding season together. Jesus loves you all and only wants the best for you.



What is a Hearing Number?

The Hearing Number is a simple metric to help you understand and monitor your hearing ability over time. It is a clinical measure for hearing loss that tells you the softest speech sound you can hear in decibels. "The Hearing Number gives everyone a way to easily understand and think about their hearing over their lifetimes beginning as a teenager," said Frank Lin, M.D., Ph.D., lead creator of the app. "By knowing their Hearing Numbers, people can understand this important aspect of their health, track the changes to their hearing that occur naturally over time, and know when to use technologies to protect their hearing and hear better."¹

3)... To encourage goodwill and mutual understanding among motorcyclists, law enforcement personnel and the general public.

4)... To serve as an information source on matters pertaining to current laws, pending legislation, personal rights, political inclinations of elected officials and their constituents, and voter awareness.

5)... To act as a central responsive agency to devise and coordinate recreational, legislative, educational, and charitable activities
