Tired of Being Tired?

Have you ever made plans to meet a friend but after an hour or so, you want to sit alone in the quiet for a while? Or, perhaps you've been to a doctor's appointment and by the time you leave you're ready for a nap? Have you attended an event with family or friends and as time passes you find it more challenging to understand what everyone is saying?

You could be experiencing auditory fatigue. Auditory fatigue is real and is experienced on occasion by many people with hearing loss. Auditory fatigue affects people in different ways and can occur regardless of age. For some, it may result in reduced attention or concentration. Others may feel tired or experience a reduction in cognitive energy, unable to listen any more after a listening effort. Some with auditory fatigue may suffer headaches after listening and may experience a strong desire to be in a quiet space or away from other people or sounds.

When you have hearing loss, your brain engages more areas to try to make sense of the sounds and words you are hearing and to figure out the words you did not hear. If the words are not clear or if you are listening in noise, the cognitive load is greater and the brain has to work harder to hear and understand the message, tune out the noise in the room, and fill in the parts that are missed. This requires more listening effort and increases stress and the feeling of fatigue.

Consequences of Auditory Fatigue

In children, fatigue is associated with reduced performance in school, increased absence from school, sleep disturbances, and changes in social relationships. For adults, fatigue is associated with greater use of sick days at work, complaints of headaches, limited participation in social engagements, and increased stress hormones. People may experience these adverse reactions due to auditory fatigue, but may not recognize that their fatigue is due to listening.

Strategies to Prevent Auditory Fatigue

- Use appropriate amplification, which reduces listening effort.
- Consider assistive listening devices that can make it easier to hear someone who speaks softly or at a distance, and when listening in noise by improving the speech-to-noise ratio.
- Consider using captioning and speech-to-text services.
- Strategically select where to sit by situating yourself near a key speaker or those you most want to hear, and away from noise sources like music speakers, kitchen noise, and ventilation systems.
- Plan listening breaks before, during, and/or after listening events. Take a quiet ride to work or school, rest before a
 party or social event, take a brief step outside during a meeting, and plan for some down time after events. Such
 breaks may only need to be a few minutes to achieve rejuvenation, though some may require longer breaks.

Consult with an audiologist to discuss solutions and strategies to combat auditory fatigue that are appropriate for your specific hearing loss and personal needs.






