

As for me, I enjoyed working and riding to college accident free, till years later when I met my wife, needed money to buy a ring and sold my beautiful blue Harley!



way to emotionally, sometimes physically, relieve our own ailments for a short period of time. It is a needed distraction. You won't get healed, but that distraction can give us relief from pain.


Don't ignore yourself, just be more loving.




